Mangalagangothri, Jan 22: The University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram bagged the overall championship prize at the 31st South Zone Inter University Youth Fest "Waves -2015" organised by Mangalore University in association with the Association of Indian Universities(AIU) and Ministry of Youth and Sports, New Delhi. The University of Kerala won 14 prizes in different events. Mahatma Gandhi University,

Kottayam emerged as runners up by winning prizes in 10 events.

Among the eight events held under the category of music and eight events under the category of fine arts, University of Kerala secured Championship, while in literary and theatre events Amritha Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Coimbatore won the championship. University of Mysore secured the championship in dance events.

University of Mysore bagged the first prize in cultural procession held as a part of the inaugural ceremony of youth festival. Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kaladi and Mangalore University bagged second and third prizes respectively.
