- There is no scope for improving Assignment marks after obtaining minimum marks. The same 4 marks will be retained in case the student appears for subsequent examinations.
- The students not submitting Assignments may appear for the examinations. However their 5 marks cards will give necessary indications.
- For writing assignments, white sheet papers shall be used and separate new sheet shall be used 6 for each assignment in each subject/paper.
- The students shall write the assignments in their own handwriting, using blue ink pen and shall 7. write in only one side of the paper.
