Prear ble:

The Government vide letter No. ED 18 VVD 2019 dtd. 16.02.2019 has instructed to reserve 5% of available seats for Physical handicapped students along with 5 years of relaxation in age limit.—Hence, the clause No.4 (c) (iii) of the Regulation governing the admission to the Post graduate Degree / Diploma Programmes of Mangalore University Departments is amended as below;

iii) 8% of the total intake shall be reserved for the students of Hyderabad- Karnataka region.	ii) Seats shall be allotted in favour of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes and other backward classes in accordance with the general or special directions of the State Government issued in this regard from time to time.	1.5% extra seats shall be allotted to the candidates of other Universities if necessary infrastructure is available in the department.
