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Employer Feedback Analysis Report 2019-20

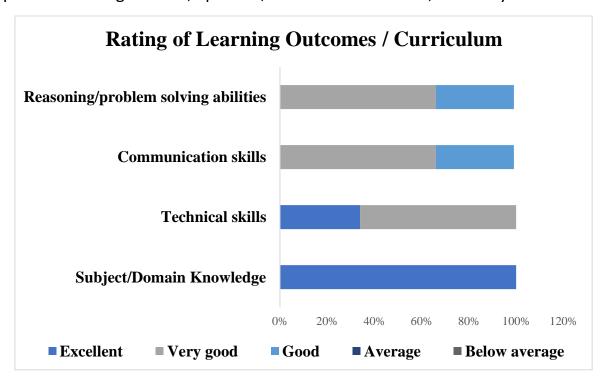
Objective:

This enables the University to evaluate the outcome and develop strategies towards better learning-based outcomes and all-round holistic development such that students are gainfully employed after leaving the Institution.

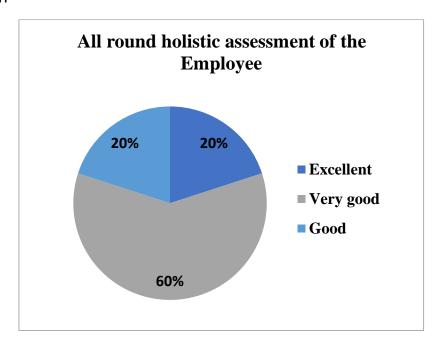
Learning outcomes/Curriculum-related questions:

The employer was asked as to how satisfied the Company/Institution was with the employee's performance. The scaling is based on a Lickert 5-point scale with quality measures from below average (0) to excellent (4).

Specific questions pertaining to learning outcomes/curriculum of the specific employee included: subject/ domain knowledge, technical skills, reasoning/ problem solving abilities, aptitude, communication skills, creativity



Specific questions pertaining to learning outcomes in terms of all round / holistic assessment of the specific employee included: participation in group discussion, team work/ team player, leadership skills, confidence levels, overall satisfaction



Specific questions pertaining to learning outcomes in terms of work/professional ethics and values of the specific employee included: work towards deadlines, motivational level, self-assessment and level of commitment/dedication, willingness to learn.
