- Since the Appeal filed by Mangalore University against the payment of Service Tax on Affiliation
 Fees/Service Charges has been decided in favor of Mangalore University, it was decided not to
 collect the GST on Affiliation fees and also decided to refund the amount to the colleges collected
 towards GST.
- An Agenda must be placed before the Karnataka State Higher Education Council to persuade the Government to waive the payment of GST on affiliation fees by representing the matter in GST Council.
- An Indemnity Bond must be executed and submitted to the University for grant of affiliation every year.
